- Date: May 25, 2017.
- Depart time to Six Flags 8:30pm- Return time home 6:00am
- Tickets are \$100.00 (NO Checks are excepted)
- You will need to fill out your Permission slip before purchasing your ticket
- Buses- if you plan on going on the bus with your group of friends you will need to purchase your tickets together. Once you are on a bus list, there will be NO changing! No expectations!!!!

Dress Code

• It is the *your responsibility* to ensure that you are dressed appropriately prior to arriving at Grad Nite.

The dress code for Grad Nite at Six Flags Magic Mountain applies to <u>all participants including</u> <u>students, guests and chaperones</u>. Anyone not adhering to the event dress code may have delayed entry into the park and may not be granted administration without finding alternate clothing. Any student or guest not permitted because of dress code must remain accompanied by a chaperone until a resolution has been found.

Student & Chaperone Dress Code Requirements

- Gentlemen are <u>required</u> to wear a collared shirt
- Chaperones/Guests are <u>required</u> to follow dress code guidelines
- Chaperones may bring in laptops/iPads & backpacks (emergency contacts, medical forms, etc.)

(Dress to Impress! If it's not listed below, you may wear it!)

- NO hats, beanies, or bandanas
- NO clothing in poor condition (including torn jeans/shirts, clothing w/spikes, sharp studs, chains, etc.)
- NO large/oversized bags of any kind

Remember:

- It is ultimately the school's responsibility to ensure that ALL students, guests, and chaperones adhere to the Grad Nite dress code.
- Six Flags Security has the right to refuse admission to anyone they deem not appropriately dressed for the event.
