

Block “L”

It is a great honor to earn and be awarded the Liberty High School block “L” and it is with great pride that it is worn and displayed. The Block “L” represents the many qualities that exemplify academic and athletic excellence as well as true Patriot Pride.

Participation and completion of the following will qualify a student for a Block “L” award:

Athletics & Cheerleading

- Completion of a Varsity Sport Season
- Completion of 2 consecutive Non-Varsity sport seasons

Participation and completion of 2 years of the following qualify for Block “L”

A Block “L” will be issued to Liberty Students when they have fulfilled the set of criteria outlined in the following handbook. If your students purchased an ASB sticker prior to the completion of the activity/sport the Block “L”, pins, and bars for each student will be free. If they do not have an ASB sticker they will have to purchase the Block “L” for \$10 and the pins/bars are \$2 each.

Drama:

Drama productions and technical theater directors, operators, actors, and technical students will be awarded a participation certificate after completing 2 consecutive major productions (fall/spring) staged. Performers and technical students will be awarded a Block “L” after participation in 4 consecutive major productions (fall/spring) staged.

ASB and Class Officers

ASB and Class Officers will qualify for a Block “L” award after 2 terms in office (does not have to be the same position for both terms)

Forensics:

Forensic team competitors in debate and individual events will be issued a Block “L” based on their NFL competition point standing. A point total of 250 or higher in the NFL will qualify a student for the Block “L” award. The Forensic Advisor will submit NFL points at the end of the year

Pins & Bars

Pins will be awarded when the Block “L” is awarded to signify the event/sport the student participated in.

Bars will be awarded for the number of season/years of participation in an event/sport.

Special Recognition

All special recognition awards are determined at the discretion of the Activity/Athletic Directors and recommendations must be submitted in writing by the advisor, coach, or teacher.
